Abstract

The conference proceedings will be published using documents submitted electronically by means of E-mail. Thus manuscripts are to be made as PDF or Postscript files and then sent to the technical committee as attached files to tech@isec-info.org with the subject "ISEC2007".

1. Introduction

In order to ensure that high quality proceedings will be published, authors are advised to prepare manuscripts following the guidelines detailed in this guide. The layout of this guide serves as an example. Should there be any doubt, please contact us via E-mail: tech@isec-info.org

2. Format of manuscripts

2.1 Paper size and pages Authors should prepare their manuscripts in double column format for printing on A4 (210mm x 297mm) paper and must ensure that the completed manuscript does not exceed **six(6)** pages.

2.2 Margins Authors must ensure that the typing area (centered) matches the guidelines given below:

- On the first page, the distance from the top edge of the paper to the top of the first line of type (i.e. the Title) should be 30mm.
- On the second and subsequent pages, the distance from the top edge of the paper to the top line of type should be 25mm.
- The bottom margin should be 25mm. No page numbers should appear in the manuscript.
- The left and right margins must be the same.
- The width of each column should be 80mm and the separation between the two columns should be 10mm.

3. Fonts

Try to use proportional *Times New Roman* font only, justified if possible, in order to avoid printing troubles. And please follow the font sizes as listed in Table 1.

4. Headings

Section headings should be centered in the column in capital letters, bold font and numbered consecutively, starting with Introduction. Sub-section headings should be numbered 1, 1.1, 1.2 etc.

5. Figures, tables, equations and references

Figures and tables must be numbered consecutively. The figure number and caption should be typed below the illustration, left justified, with subsequent lines

indented. Footnotes should be avoided if possible.

Equations use the following format.

$$c\rho A \frac{\partial T}{\partial t} = \mathbf{a}S(T_g - T) \quad (1)$$

$$W = \oint p dV \quad (2)$$

List and number all references at the end of the paper. When citing references in the text, type the corresponding number in square brackets as shown at the end of this sentence[1].

Authors' names	12 pt.
Authors' affiliation	10 pt.
Authors' address and E-mail	10 pt.
Main text	10 pt.
Section title	11 pt.
Figure captions	10 pt.

6. For Electronic Submission via E-mail

Note in particular that for PDF files, *only type 1 font* should be used, to minimize the risk of printing errors. And please note that the manuscript file must not exceed 2Mbytes due to the capacity of our mail server. Authors must strictly keep the following deadlines.
